Regional Championship Qualifying Fee Change: The Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Championships qualifying fee has changed to \$20 for 2025 Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Championships qualifying competitions.

USDF Non-Member Fee Change: The USDF Non-member fee is changing to \$55 (Effective October 1, 2024).

Dues and Fee Increases for the 2025 Membership Year

Please be sure you are using the correct membership and horse registration forms, as dues and fees are increasing, effective December 1, 2024. Failure to use the appropriate forms will cause delays in the processing of your competitions' results.

F.A.B. Award

Developed by the Outreach, Awareness, and Inclusion (OAI) Taskforce and approved by the Executive Board in Spring of 2024, USDF is pleased to make available the new F.A.B. Award. The F.A.B. Award certificate is available online with the other competition forms, to be printed out and provided to judges and/or TDs at your competition to handout/award to deserving individuals at competitions, recognized or otherwise. There is no membership requirement to receive the award, and it can be presented to anyone from a competitor, scribe, or volunteer, to janitor, concession stand worker, etc. that the presenter feels has gone above and beyond in their efforts and are deserving of recognition. Instructions for the recipient to be recognized by USDF are included on the certificate and nothing additional is required or competition management beyond providing the certificates. We hope you will take part in recognizing these oft overlooked and unsung individuals!
